Subject- Amendment of Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy, 2021

No.4709-TRN-LC-RT-0003/2017/T.- Whereas Government of Odisha have notified the " Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy,2021" vide Resolution No.7645/T dt.01.09.2021 published in the Extraordinary Gazette No.1358 dated the 2nd September,2021 with an aim for adoption of 20% electric vehicles by the end of 2025 as a measure of reduction of vehicular pollution.

However, it is found that about 4.48% of electric vehicles have been registered by the end of 2022 which is not satisfactory in comparison to the policy objective.

Now therefore, Government in pursuance of clause-11.5 of the Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy, 2021 have been pleased to amend clause 4.1.1 of the said Policy, i.e., the purchase incentive which will be effective during Policy period as follows:

Sl. No.	Category of vehicle	Percentage of cost of vehicle as subsidy	Maximum amount of subsidy
1.	Two wheelers	Rs. 5000/- per kWh	Rs. 20,000/-
2.	Three wheelers	-	Rs 30,000/- per vehicle (flat)
3.	Four Wheelers	Four Wheelers: Rs. 10,000/- per kWh	Rs. 1,50,000/-

No.758—TRN-LC-RT-0003-2017/T.— Whereas, on the advice of NITI Aayog, Government of Odisha have published the Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy, 2021 in Extraordinary issue No. 1358 dated 2nd September, 2021 of *Odisha Gazette* in order to encourage faster adoption of Electric Vehicles in the State. Under the policy guideline, the State Government have proposed to extend a lot of incentives for the purchasers, Manufacturers of EVs, Batteries and Charging stations which are to be extended by different Stake Holder Departments. As the first step, this Department have exempted the registration fees and Motor Vehicle Taxes for all categories of Electric Vehicles vide Notification No.9191 dated the 29th October, 2021.

Now, the State Government in terms of clause 4.1.1 of Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy, 2021 have decided to give subsidy to various Electric Vehicle Buyers during the Policy period , i.e., up to dated the 31st December, 2025 as follows :

Sl. No.	Category of vehicle	Percentage of cost of vehicle as subsidy	Maximum amount of subsidy
1	Two wheelers	15%	Rs. 5,000/-
2	Three wheelers	15%	Rs.10,000/-
3	Four Wheelers	15%	Rs. 50,000/-

The above subsidy is applicable w.e.f. dated the 1 September, 2021 and the amount will be credited to the Bank Accounts of the beneficiaries by the concerned RTO where the vehicle is registered / will be registered.

The Transport Commissioner with the help of NIC/ OCAC will develop a dedicated Portal to monitor all information relating to EV sales, crediting of purchase incentives, subsidy on loans for purchase of EV etc.

No.9191—TRN-LC-RT-0003-2017/T.— Whereas, the Ministry of Road Transport & Highways, Government of India vide Notification No. G.S.R. 525(E) dated the 2nd August, 2021 published in the Extraordinary issue of Gazette of India No. 426 dated the 3rd August, 2021, have amended the Central Motor Vehicle Rules, 1989 whereby for the Battery Operated Vehicles as defined in clause (u) of rule 2 of CMV Rules have been exempted from payment of fees mentioned under Sl. No. 4 of Table of rule 81 of the said Rules for the purpose of issue or renewal of registration certificate and assignment of new registration mark.

And, whereas, on the advice of NITI Aayog, Government of Odisha have published the Odisha Electric Vehicle Policy, 2021 in Extraordinary issue No. 1358 dated the 2nd September, 2021 of *Odisha Gazette* in order to encourage faster adoption of Electric Vehicles in the State, and under the policy guideline, the State Government have proposed to extend a lot of incentives for the purchasers, Manufacturers of EVs , Batteries and Charging stations .Under the said policy, the Government shall allow 100% exemption on Motor Vehicles taxes and Registration fees for the Policy period in order to encourage faster adoption of Electric Vehicles in the State.
